



- Users will be able to generate custom reports with desired fields


Improved Efficiency:

- Subscribers with in-house mapping technology or who use freely-available map viewers such as ArcGIS Explorer will have DHR's most current and **live** locational information.

V-CRIS incorporates state-of-the-art technology to provide easy access to information, streamlined data entry and reporting, and enhanced functionality that responds to user requests.
