Erected in 1834, St. Peter's Church was the first church built on what is now Grace Street, and is the oldest Roman Catholic Church in Richmond. From 1850, when Richmond became a separate diocese, until 1905, when the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart was erected, St. Peter's served as a cathedral church.

The Church has been attended by many well-known people including Littleton Tazewell, Governor of Virginia from 1834-36; the various French consuls residing in Richmond; famed Civil War General Beauregard; and Pearl Tyler, daughter of President John Tyler, who was married there.

St. Peter's stands today as one of the gems of nineteenth century ecclesiastical architecture in Richmond. Its location, along with St. Paul's Episcopal Church across the street, adds to the visual effect of the western end of Capitol Square and the Richmond cityscape.

The interior of St. Peter's has suffered few serious alterations, and survives in an excellent state of repair. The bays are divided by curious Doric pilasters with Ionic capitals over the Doric. Other notable interior features are the very shallow transepts and semi-circular apse./

The church offices next door are fine examples of Edwardian townhouses.
