




Figure C.1 Stewart, Watts, and Smith Location overview




Figure C.2 Stewart Cemetery (DHR No. 096-5301) Site Plan






Figure D.1 Stewart, Watts, and Smith Location overview.




Figure D.2 Watts Cemetery (096-5302) Site Plan








Figure E.1 Stewart, Watts, and Smith Location overview




Figure E.2 Smith Cemetery 096-5303) Site Plan
